




OECD Survey of Drivers of Trust in Public Institutions


In 2023, the share of people with low or no trust in government (44%) outweighs those with high or moderately high trust (39%)

Share of respondents who indicate different levels of trust in their national government (on a 0-10 scale), 2023




Feeling that you have a say in government actions affect trust levels

Trust, voice and participation






What is citizen participation in policymaking?

Citizen participation in policymaking can improve policy outcomes, build trust and contribute to democratic resilience. It can be defined as "all the ways in which stakeholders (including citizens) can be involved in the policy cycle and in service design and delivery"*. This can range from informing, to consulting, to engaging on equal standing with government, to shaping policy outcomes.


OECD Survey of Adult Skills links skills and self-efficacy






